Situated on the banks of the Currumbene Creek, 200km south of Sydney and close to the natural attractions of beautiful Jervis Bay, is a safari-style camp that leads the way in eco luxury.

Many struggle with how to offer luxury without compromising standards, but Paperbark Camp does so without impacting upon the pristine surrounds that drew guests in the first place.

Eco-tourism at its best, the camp departs greatly from the traditional idea of tent-based roughing-it and provides a comfortable base from which to explore the beauty of the region.

Accommodation comprises eight elevated safari-style tents with open-air ensuite bathrooms, queen-size beds, fresh linen and locally crafted furnishings. Each tent boasts its own wraparound veranda set among towering gum and paperbark trees.

For the ultimate in immersive indulgence, those guests staying in one of four luxury safari tents can enjoy a sudsy soak in a bush bath with a view.

The "Gunyah" is the property's central communal area and it's ideal for relaxing in front of the fire in winter or dining on the veranda during warmer months.

Activities include canoeing, bike riding, bushwalking, birdwatching and spotlighting for nocturnal animals such as gliders and possums. Alternatively, guests may prefer to spend an afternoon relaxing with a good book while keeping an eye out for passing kangaroos.

Jervis Bay has long been a local secret, but it is increasingly being discovered by visitors to Australia, and offers spectacular diving, snorkelling, surfing and bushwalking.

A short scenic drive away are the additional



attractions of Arthur Boyd's art centre "Bundanon", local vineyards, cellar doors and the quaint country towns of Berry and Kangaroo Valley.

Paperbark Camp is ideal for those who love being close to nature, but equally appreciate the finer things in life. A sumptuous menu is prepared daily using locally sourced produce helping make Paperbark Camp an experience and destination you won't want to leave.
